
Before the late 17th century, when pewter, silver and ceramics became available as tableware, the majority of items used were from carved wood, or "treen" - anything from wooden plates and bowls, <u>snuff boxes</u> and needle cases, spoons to shoehorns and chopping boards can be classed as treen. Today, treen is highly collectable for its patina and tactile appeal. So please bring along any treen items you may have at home or small antique/vintage woodenware pieces.
